Lease Packages

Lease of a horse/pony owned or provided by JPT includes:

- Full grooming services for horses/ponies, including:
 - Turnout, lunging and/or hand walking as needed
 - Preparation and tacking up of the horse and post-ride care
 - Trimming/Mane pulling
 - Blanketing/Bandaging
 - Administer medications and feed
 - Incidental medical supplies/care (wound dressing, poultice)
- Board at Portola Farms
- Barn supplies
- Shoeing and basic veterinary services
 - Extra veterinary maintenance is not included
- Daily laundry (towels, wraps, saddle pads, girths, boots, etc)
- Guidance in purchasing equipment (saddles, bridles, tack trunks, blankets, rider attire)

Horse Shows

Horse Shows

 Other Clients canceling after entires close are responsible for scratch fees, show office administrative fees, stall fees, and show expenses listed above (not including feed and bedding), regardless of cancellation reason. All entrants must bring 3 checks per show for payment of show entries, braiding, and grooming. There will be a \$100 service charge per horse when JPT has to cover show expenses. 	
Deposit Due prior to each show, credited toward bill	\$500



Sales and Leases

JPT will work with clients to buy, sell and lease horses as requested. This service includes finding potential prospects, trying horses, overseeing veterinary exams, evaluating show record history, and negotiating prices and terms. JPT will charge a commission fee of 10% for these services, which will be based on the sales, purchase, or lease price of the horse. All travel, hotel, rental car and meal expenses are to be paid by the client. A consulting fee of \$100/day will be paid by the prospective buyer to JPT. This fee will be deducted from the commission when purchase or lease is complete. You will be responsible for a pre-purchase veterinary exam before purchasing, and a smaller vet exam for leases. Insurance is also highly recommended when purchasing and required when leasing horses outside of JPT. Expect around 3.5% of purchase price.

Billing and Payment

Invoices are sent at the beginning of each month. Training is billed at the beginning of the month, as are deposits for horse shows. Horse show charges will be invoiced after the show. Bills are due within 10 days of the invoice date. Late fees will be charged at a rate of 18% per annum in addition to a monthly re-billing fee of \$25.

30-day notice is required for all horses leaving the training program.
